The CSHSE Board met on February 15, 2019 to review the requested additional information for the College of DuPage Human Service Generalist AAS program. It is my privilege to inform you that the Human Service Generalist AAS program at College of DuPage has been reaccruited by the Council for Standards in Human Service Education for the period of October 2018 through October 2023. The conditional accreditation standing is removed effective February 15, 2019
