Dear Dr. Trask,

I received your reaccreditation application, request for an extension form, and confirmation of accreditation fee payment from ASCENT. Based upon your rationale for the extension request, your extension request is approved. The reaccreditation cycle for the baccalaureate Human Services-Clinical Concentration program will remain from June 2021- June 2026 because the year extension will be included within this reaccreditation cycle.

The extension cannot exceed one year from the date that the reaccreditation was due. Thus, the self-study must be submitted and reviewed and the site visit held before June 2022.

The Board meets in October 2021 and February 2022 during your year extension. Your program can also opt to submit your self-study, if ready, for the October or February meeting.
